“Why do we not pray the Creed anymore?” This question was left in one of the boxes in the foyer of St. Rose Worship Site.

Answer: When it comes to praying the Creed, the Roman Missal States *“At the end of the homily, the Symbol (‘the Symbol – period of silence) or Profession of Faith or Creed, when prescribed, is either sung or said.”* Taken from 2011 Roman Missal #18 pg. 500.

Since the beginning of Easter, I have been using the second option, “The Profession of Faith,” where publicly we profess our belief by ‘renewing our baptismal promise. The Profession of Faith consists of a series of questions asked by the priest and the community responding with “I do.” Therefore, we have been praying the Creed, using option 2... The Profession of Faith. **Something to ponder:** “When we enter the church with the intention of participating in the Mass, is that not in itself a Profession of Faith?”
