#### RELIGIOUS EDUCATION UPDATE – FEBRUARY 2021

We started posting and sending out home study modules the first week in January, one packet for grade 1-5, a second for Grade 6-8, as well as weekly postings for preschool activities and bible stories for the younger family members, and feedback so far has been positive. These lessons, especially for the younger ages require more parental and family involvement, but, especially these days with limited access to organized Church activities that may be a bonus!

The study packets for First Reconciliation and First Communion have also been delivered. These are the same lessons we used last year as a review for the First Communion students who had had some in person teaching, but needed to refresh before receiving the Sacrament. We also used a questionnaire format to assess their readiness, and it seemed to work well.

During the upcoming Lenten Season, we will be posting much more frequent lessons and activities, both on the Holy Spirit Faithbook page, and in the Religious Education Group for registered students; probably not daily, but similar-to the posts during the first months of the pandemic, before we regained some structure and control in our lives.

We are still accepting registration for students. We currently have a total of 42 students, and are trying to collect names to see who is actively following the program at this time. !2 are receiving the lessons via e-mail, but there is no way of knowing without feedback how many are using the posted lessons.

#### TRIDUUM...SILENCE...and the Pandemic?

Each Triduum, you have been encouraged to embrace the 'action' of silence for the Three Days and in the past, YOU HAVE... YOU HAVE DONE IT VERY, VERY WELL AT BOTH WORSHIP SITES!!! However, due to the ongoing pandemic, we have had to make some practical changes for this Triduum. Due to the uncertainty of the current pandemic, and with the support of the Liturgical Committee, we will be simplifying this year's celebrations. With that being said, their sacredness and solemnity of our liturgies will be retained.

So once again, we ask that at the end of the Holy Thursday the community is invited to stay and spend some time in quiet prayer before the Blessed Sacrament at St. Matthew's Worship Site between 8-9 pm. When leaving the church after Holy Thursday Celebration, the faithful are called to leave in silence. Then the Good Friday liturgy begins in silence and ends in the same manner. The faithful, out of respect for solemnity of the Triduum, are called to be mindful of this prayerful time. That means **no talking** in the church or at the entrance of the church (other than the pandemic team's questions) and everyone is to be seated. On Good Friday, instead of venerating the Cross individually, we will do a communal veneration instead. By staying in our seats, we will be offered ample time to venerate the cross...sitting in silence, kneeling, or standing. Once again, we continue to worship in silence. On Saturday and Sunday we will celebrate the Resurrection of Jesus Christ. Due to social distancing, the number allowed at each worship site, means that some additional modifications have been made to the Triduum. The pandemic continues to stretch our ability to do almost everything...including our liturgical celebrations. Once again, we will celebrate the Triduum while working in our 'boundaries'. Yes, this year will be a bit different, but it's more than what we had last year, which was nothing. May we hold each other up, including the needs of our community as we celebrate the ultimate gift of hope: the Resurrection of Jesus Christ!
